

Re: 2023 Tree Seedling Production Request for Service – Pic Forest and White River Forest

November 2, 2021

The Nawiingnokiima Forest Management Corporation (NFMC) is accepting proposals to produce some or all 6,150,000 conifer seedlings for the Pic and/or White River Forest(s) to be delivered in the spring of 2023. The preferred seedling stock production required is as follows:

Requested volumes listed in the table above indicate the preferred stock production amounts for our 2023 stock production. The NFMC is open to proposals and agreements entailing seedling volumes that best suit individual nursery operations if discounts are applicable.

The options presented may be allotted to nurseries individually or combined depending on pricing proposals. Please include information regarding volume discounts if applicable and the location that the seeds will be grown. The attached agreement Schedule A will form part of the contractual agreement entered with the successful supplier(s).

Please submit bids in Canadian dollars (\$)/1,000 trees grown using the summary sheet provided. Please note that all proposals should include information on: container type, packaging, shipping, the growing location as well as any other relevant information. All costs associated with this contract (including costs of delivering seedlings to various locations anywhere within the Pic and White River Forests must be included in your bid price. **Your bid price per 1,000 trees will be considered final.**

The NFMC reserves the right to modify container types and to select one or more service suppliers for this engagement. The NFMC makes no guarantee of the value or volume of work to be assigned to the successful supplier(s).
